A Journey so Far.....

In a world where English is the Lingua franca and about 1,500,000 people speak English and another 1,000,000,000 are learning it, we need to awaken to the winds of change in the world around us and widen the horizons of our thinking and working.

It is amazing that learning just one language gives access to the knowledge available on the Internet. Only English Language magazines and newspapers can be found in every part of the world. Almost all International Conferences and Competitions are conducted in English. 75% of the world's letters and postcards are written in English. Accepting this obvious reality, Anjuman-I-Islam decided to introduce an English Medium School with the aim of catering to those of our community who since long had been desiring to send their girls to English Medium Schools, but not at the cost of their culture, tradition and demands of religion. Anjuman-I-Islam attempted to fulfill their long cherished dreams in the guise of Begum Sharifa Kalsekar Girls' English School.

In the year 2001, the sole contribution of the philanthropist, Mr. Haji Abdul Razzak Kalsekar materialized the construction of the new building for the English Medium School. The building was inaugurated at the hands of his wife, Begum Sharifa Kalsekar and the school was named after her. The School started functioning in full swing from June 2002 with JR. K.G., SR. K.G. and Standard I.

At present, the school runs in perfect harmony and comprises of 3 sections the Pre-Primary, Primary and the Secondary.

The Secondary School works in the morning from 7:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.

Our school consists of students from varied backgrounds, thus forming mixed background.

Staffing: We have 28 full time trained teaching staff, 1 Band Teacher, 2 Karate teachers, and 2 Computer teaching staff, supported by 3 Clerks and 8 peons. The staff is a healthy mixture of young as well as experienced staff.

Curriculum: The academic curriculum is well planned and organized and every detail is considered so as to give maximum input to our students. A weekly timetable of 50 periods is in operation, each day having 10 periods each. Special emphasis is also laid on 'Health Education as well as Environmental Education' as we believe in 'Sound Mind in a Sound body.' We have 2 divisions each in all the classes right from Std. I to Std. X and the 3rd division is on its way and the students are placed in mixed ability forms. Students with particular learning difficulties are supported in class, in small groups via special extra class or on an individual basis.

Extra-Curricular Activities: There is a wide range of wholesome extra curricular activities that are held round the year to cater to the needs of our creative minds. Emphasis is laid on maximum student participation. These activities are held in school, there are some inter-school activities and now we believe to forge ahead with international activities thus widening their learning experiences.
